This reconstructed, Late-Classical manor house from 1920 with large grounds is located in the village of Melčice near Trenčín. With an enchanting atmosphere, it offers exceptional living and is a great investment if used as a hotel/guest house, private clinic, or doctors' office. The property is not registered as a cultural monument.

The manor consists of two wings. The ground floor consists of a large entrance hall, kitchen, training room, administrative section with three offices, storage space, toilet, **sauna**, and lounge. The second wing has a rear entrance from a **terrace covered with greenery**, a lounge, a cloakroom for employees, a utility room, a kitchen, a storage room, and two toilets. No basement. On the upper floor is a corridor, a utility room, and **6 rooms**, each with a bathroom and toilet.

The brick building, which was **tastefully renovated in 2022**, has four entrances to the property. Standard facilities include wood insulated windows, **oak doors**, **ceramic floors**, carpets, **Siberian larch** stairs, and underfloor cooling. Two heat pumps are **energy-efficient** (saving approx. EUR 200 per month). The property is connected to electricity, water, and has a septic tank and an OV purifier.

The manor is located in a quiet, undisturbed location, surrounded by beautiful nature outside the hustle and bustle of the city. The large, sloping plot with ornamental trees provides parking for 10-14 cars.

The village of Melčice lies in a Central Povazie valley in the White Carpathian Mountains only 15 minutes from Trenčín and offers many opportunities for active relaxation—hiking, biking, tennis, or golf. Tourist attractions in the area include the Beckov or Čachtice castles, and especially the historic town of Trenčín. The village provides complete civic amenities, including a train station with a main line to Bratislava.
