

Behind a wall of bushy trees and a thick hedge, in the middle of a vast garden, an exceptionally well-preserved functionalist villa from the 1930s is set combining the possibility of multigenerational living with business. The property is conveniently located in the center of Moravské Budějovice, close to the park, sports grounds and the bus and train station.

From the beginning, the first (usable area $153,35 \, \text{m}^2$) floor was reserved for the needs of a **medical office** with a waiting room and all the necessary facilities, on the 1st and 2nd floors there are **2 spacious apartments** (145.38 m^2 and $138.34 \, \text{m}^2$). The house has a **basement**. The windows, balconies and conservatory offer **beautiful views of the greenery**.

The villa was built by the prominent doctor Josef Salač, and was completed in 1938 according to the design of the respected architects of the time, the brothers J. and K. Fišer, who participated in many important constructions, including the villas on Prague's Baba. In 2018, the building underwent a thorough renovation, during which original architectural and craft elements were preserved, for example doors with original handles, staircases, built-in furniture or tiled stoves. The garden is decorated with mature trees and water features, there is also a swimming pool, hot tub or fireplace. It is also advantageous to divide the land belonging to the villa into a total of three parts, two of which can be built on. Parking garage and on the private property next to the villa for another 2 cars.

The picturesque town of Moravské Budějovice, located in the beautiful landscape of South Moravia, offers everything you need for a happy life. There is a kindergarten and elementary school, a post office, a library, outdoor and indoor sports facilities - tennis courts, a football field, a winter stadium, a swimming pool, a fitness center or a bowling alley, and of course there are shops including a supermarket, a polyclinic, a pharmacy and several restaurants. The dominant feature of the city is a baroque castle surrounded by a park. Moravské Budějovice has convenient bus and train connections with the surrounding towns, and by car it is possible to easily connect to the first-class E59 road and take it to, for example, Jihlava or Znoimo.
