



Life in the heart of the city is yours to enjoy from this bright apartment with a terrace on the 6th floor of the Dlouhá Palace with modern, spacious units designed for prestigious living with preserved original elegance. The architecturally significant building was built in 1929 in the Art Deco style and has a strategic location on the corner of Dlouhá and Hradební streets, close to the Old Town and Republic squares.

The living room with a kitchen and dining room is connected to the eastfacing terrace facing the Hradební quiet side street. A bedroom with a walkin dressing room also has access to the terrace and the bright bathroom with a freestanding bathtub and large window faces the courtyard. There is also a second smaller bathroom, a bedroom, a vestibule, and a utility room.

The facilities include oak parquet floors, a kitchen with built-in appliances, and replicas of the original casement windows. The unit has a parking space in an automated parking system at extra cost of CZK 1000 000. The building was designed in the workshop of the Prague expressionist architect Paul Sydow and his collaborator Otomar Sušický and was completely reconstructed by the DAM architectural studio, which took care to preserve the residential, commercial, and cultural functions of the palace.

During the reconstruction, the Gurmet Passage was created with a wide range of international and local food, a café, and a bistro. There is also an entrance to the Theater in Dlouhá. The neighborhood is also home to the NoD gallery, the Roxy club, and plenty of spots to go for good food, drinks, or fun. Within easy reach are shopping opportunities—small boutiques to shopping malls—a kindergarten and elementary school, medical services, a post office, and everything else needed for everyday life. A tram stop and an entrance to the metro station is a few steps from the building.
